## **BSPGHAN BSPGHAN Virtual Education Teaching Sessions**

### **Code of Conduct for Speakers**

The BSPGHAN endorsed Virtual Teaching Education session or resource must be consistent with the BSPGHAN Constitution

***The objectives of the Society shall be the advancement of research, clinical excellence and training in paediatric gastroenterology, hepatology and nutrition.***

Endorsed courses or meetings are those that the Society consider as being relevant and important for BSPGHAN Members

1. Speakers will be invited by – Chair of Education Group or appropriate designated person.
  - a. The presenter must declare any Conflict of Interest
  - b. The content of the teaching session or resource should be determined predominantly by the Invited speaker
  - c. The content must not have any restrictions or qualifying requirements imposed by any commercial sponsor
  - d. The teaching session must be relevant to the Society
  - e. Invited speaker must include statement that teaching/resource does not necessarily represent the views of the society
2. Speakers will be asked for permission to upload slides with audio presentation to the BSPGHAN website, members' only area. Access is only granted to BSPGHAN members. It will be the responsibility of the presenter to ensure all confidential data are removed from slides.
3. Where BSPGHAN agrees to endorse a virtual teaching session or resource, the Society will
  - a. Include the course or meeting on the BSPGHAN website events calendar
  - b. Include the course or meeting in the BSPGHAN eNewsletter
  - c. Will ask for formal feedback that will be shared with invited speaker and included in the annual report
  - d. Provide a Certificate of Attendance to all delegates

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
