

Locum Consultant Paediatric Gastroenterologist, Nottingham Children's Hospital, Nottingham University Hospitals NHS Trust

A full-time post has arisen as a result of a vacancy in the current consultant establishment and it is anticipated that the position will become a substantive position within a short period of time. Nottingham Children's Hospital is part of Nottingham University Hospitals NHS Trust and is based at the Queen's Medical Centre. It has the full range of specialist paediatric services including paediatric intensive care, oncology, neurology and neurosurgery, rheumatology, ENT, plastic surgery, cardiology, renal transplant and surgery.

The paediatric gastroenterology department provides comprehensive tertiary paediatric services for a large part of the East Midlands and surrounding regions (population 2.6 million). The team is supported by three other doctors on the middle grade rota: 1 Grid Registrar, 1 Paediatric Registrar, 1 Clinical fellow; 1 SHO, 2.5 WTE band 7 IBD/Liver Nurse Specialists and 1.4 WTE Band 6 Gastroenterology Nurse Specialists, 0.5 WTE Investigations Nurse, 2.2 WTE Specialist Dietitians, 2 PAs, one patient pathway coordinator and one Waiting List coordinator. The department works collaboratively with established paediatric services in the network and specialist services at the Children's Hospital. There are established formal links with paediatric hepatology at Birmingham Children's Hospital and Leeds General Infirmary with 7 consultant led supra-regional liver clinics occurring per year. The department is recognised by the RCPCH CSAC for training in PGMAN and participates on the Training Grid between East and West Midlands. It has close clinical and research links with the Nottingham Digestive Disease Centre and with the Biomedical Research Centre (BRC), studying gastrointestinal and liver diseases. Joint transition clinics with colleagues in the adult gastroenterology service take place 12 times a year.

The candidate must be registered with the GMC and be on the GMC Specialist Register or within six months of their expected date of CCT on the date of interview.
