A £1,000 prize for the best essay on gastroenterology, hepatology or pancreatology research personally undertaken by medical students who were on an intercalated BSc/MRes/MSc/MPH/MBPhD* course during the previous academic year (2022/23)

Four £1,500 prizes for medical students taking full-time science degrees (BSc/MRes/MSc/MPH/MBPhD*) focusing on gastrointestinal or liver-related disease in the current academic year (2022/23)

Two £2,500 awards for F1/F2 doctors to facilitate prospective research in an area relevant to gastroenterology, hepatology or pancreatology

A £1,000 award for primary and secondary care gastrointestinal/liver nurses for initiatives that have improved patient care (nominate your colleague today for this award)

A £1,000 award for dietitians working in gastroenterology / hepatology / pancreatology for initiatives that have improved patient care

SpR Trainee Audit/Quality Improvement Awards

Up to £10,000 available for UK-based gastroenterology / hepatology / pancreatology speciality trainees who would like to conduct an audit or quality improvement project in any area of gastroenterology, liver disease or nutrition
